Dear Parishioners,

Many things have happened financially since the last time it was my turn to write, most of them negative. No doubt, you've read in the papers or on the internet the horrible situation of our state coffers. Larry Gerston who teaches political science at San Jose State University wrote in the May 21 issue of the San Jose Mercury News that budget cuts will decimate California's safety net. The planned cuts will put our state 47th in spending on public education, 50th in spending on highways, and 49th in number of state employees. "Additional cuts will render the state into developing nation status," he writes. The San Francisco Chronicle laments millions of children without health care and the closure of state parks, one of the few places families can go without paying a fortune. Mr. Gerston proposes five "defensible sources of new money" for the state: broadening the sales tax (40 states take more items than we do), restoring the vehicle license fee (would bring in about \$6 billion); increasing the tax on alcohol (hasn't been changed in almost 20 years), taxing oil producers (we're the only state which doesn't); and cancelling recent corporate tax breaks (recently given as teachers were laid off and the disabled lost health care workers). And as one wise parishioner couple told me recently, "We need to pay higher taxes."

What does all this have to do with our recent celebration of the Feast of Pentecost or this Sunday's Feast of the Most Holy Trinity? Do we really believe that Jesus has given us the Spirit to carry on his mission? Do we believe that, whatever else the Trinity means, it signifies a relationship, a community of love? And even though many of us learned that we were made in the image and likeness of God" I'd guess that I'm not the only one who thought that meant that we had intelligence and feeling, as God does. Now, I'm convinced that our being made in the image of God means that we're made for love, we're made to be in community – or many communities -- the family, the parish, our friends, our colleagues at work or classmates at school, our neighbors. And if that's true, we have to be concerned about the children without health care; the teacher with a larger class, fewer resources and a shorter year in which to teach her charges; and the homebound person with little or no care giving assistance. Our state legislators, as you may know, are Representative Jackie Speier at 342-0300 and Senator Jerry Hill at 349-1900. They are under great pressure, but they also need to hear from us. May the Spirit guide them and ourselves in this stressful, challenging time!




