Dear Parishioners,

The full nature of the Kingdom of Heaven exceeds the power of human language to express it. But Jesus reveals many insights into this mystery through parables, three of which are in today's Gospel reading.

The parable of the sower reveals that the Kingdom is in the world, but remains partly hidden by competing elements. The parable of the mustard seed reveals that the Kingdom's presence in the world begins so small that it's hard to see, but will grow to dwarf everything else. And the parable of the yeast reveals that even a small presence of the Kingdom will spread its effects throughout the world.

The Gospels reveal that the Kingdom to which we are called is nothing less than the fullness of God's Life. Through faith we become more aware of the Kingdom's presence among us; through our efforts to follow Jesus the Kingdom grows both within and around us; and through the gift of grace we become more fully united with God's Life. May we always seek to grow in that grace as disciples of Jesus, and experience more deeply the peace of the Kingdom.
