Dear Friends,

As I sit here on our deck, enjoying the beauty of Gene's garden, my white butterfly circles around my head. Maybe he'd like a sip of my mango tea! As I look over the readings for today, I ask Gene to help me find the right words to say to you.

In the first reading from the Book of Kings, God speaks to Elijah, telling him that He will be passing by. God isn't in the strong and heavy wind. He isn't in the earthquake. He isn't in the fire. God is in the tiny whispering sound. The gentle Spirit of God lives within each of us. If we but ask, He will speak to our hearts with whispers of comfort, guidance and love. It isn't an actual voice we hear. It is a knowing deep within our being that God is here. He is communicating with us.

In the Gospel according to Matthew, we see that Jesus first of all feeds the hungry people; then He goes up to the mountain to pray. Today so many people are hungry. Do we just go up on our mountain by ourselves and pray, ignoring their needs; or will we be like Jesus?

The boat that his friends are in is being tossed about by the wind and waves. Jesus knows that they are frightened so He comes to them, walking on the sea. At the sight of Jesus, they become even more frightened; in fact, they are terrified. Jesus tells them: **"Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid."**

Peter (the presumably "fearless one") isn't sure if this is really Jesus, but he takes a chance. He steps out of the boat and begins to walk on water. Suddenly his courage deserts him and Peter begins to sink. He cries out to Jesus: "Lord, save me!"

Have you been there with Peter? I know I have many times. I get in over my head and become frightened. It is then that I need to reach out to Jesus and cry out: "Lord, save me!" He always hears my prayer and I say to myself: "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"


