The Blessing of A New Year

I want to share a bit of my experience in New Orleans almost 6 1/2 years after Katrina. Three of us, Joan Sexton, Carolyn Pretzer (an Associate with my Franciscan community) and I worked our first days in the Ninth Ward where there are no sidewalks and families do their regular shopping at the Dollar General. The African American woman who owns the house has been a victim of contractor fraud and has been broken into; she presently lives in the smallest trailer I've ever seen. Her two children are staying with relatives until their home is habitable. We did three stages of mold remediation and after the last stage is completed by another group, the insulation and drywall can be put in. It is a long, slow process, as those of you in construction know well! Yesterday, we "mudded" in a house belonging to a distant relative of the Dalai Lama who was back in Nepal visiting his dying father. Our third site was another house near Lake Pontchartrain.

Sunday, we worshipped with a gracious, lively congregation at a gospel Mass at St. Peter Claver Church. The deacon's homily was so inspiring! He spoke of how awareness of our blessings can help us carry the spirit of Christmas into the new year. He explained that the gospel words that Mary "kept all these things, reflecting on them in her heart" in the original Greek meant that she sorted and organized these happenings and dialogued with them, seeking to understand the Whatever 2011 has depths of their meaning. contained for us personally, we can choose to pay attention to the hardships or the blessings. Mary could have been angry about the abrupt disruption to her dream of an ordinary life with Joseph. She could have been furious that no one would make room for her to bring forth her child. But instead, she praises God. How about us?




