#### Dear Parishioners,

Last week, we heard the call of Samuel and were encouraged to reflect on our call in baptism and our call today. These readings continue that theme of call, but with a new sense of urgency about them. Jonah tells the people to repent or Nineveh will be destroyed in 40 days. And they do repent when he's walked through one third of the city! (Today's reading doesn't include it, but Jonah is angry because he felt the people were so bad, they should be destroyed.) The reading from I Corinthians warns that the world as we know it is passing away. Then in the gospel, Jesus says "the kingdom of God is at hand" and calls two sets of brothers to help him bring about that kingdom.

What are we doing to answer that call of God to live out the reality of being his daughters and sons? Some of us are caring for an ill family member, some are assisting someone at work or school so he/ she can progress; some of us offer our infirmities and pray constantly for the needs of the world. Some of us have felt a call to help the poor families we met through the six week summer grocery program you supported so graciously. Now, through collaboration with Second Harvest Food Bank and the First Filipino United Church of Christ on Linden Ave. we can help those families access healthy food by registering for the Family Harvest and CalFresh (used to be called food stamps or SNAP) Programs. You can be involved, too, by spreading the word to your neighbors, co-workers and friends. The Food Bank also has a Brown Bag program for seniors and a mobile pantry of fresh fruits and vegetables. I have bilingual fliers (English/Spanish) for Family Harvest and trilingual ones (those two plus Vietnamese) for all the various programs the food bank provides. Just see me before or after any of the Sunday Masses and I'll gladly give you some. It seems scandalous to me that anyone in California should go hungry when we provide so much of the produce for the rest of the country. If you'd like to hear about other ways you can be involved, please let me know in person or by e-mail, sheralmar@aol.com. Thank you. Meanwhile, let's pray for the discipline it takes to spend some quality time each day or evening to listen for the Lord's call.


