Dear Parishioners,

A teacher in her third year in a catholic girls high school teaching five classes of religion - one of her classes including gifted seniors - as the semester begins the seniors test her limits . A student asks a question and makes fun of her response. The class giggles and snickers and sneers. As the power struggle develops something happens to her in that moment. She walks around the lectern, looks hard at this student and says something like "Look Liz, you are a very good student, a leader. What you are doing in the classroom is disruptive and unjust to the other students. You are not alone, but you are a leader. I will not have it. It is just not fair".

Five years later one evening she has a guest. Liz has come to tell her that she is living in a catholic worker home working with the poor and promoting systematic change to make society more just and fair for all. Liz wants her to know that she had heard every word in class that year. It shaped her life and she has come to say thank you.


The teacher thanks her back because she was so moved. Transformation happens in mysterious ways. One never knows. The Orthodox Church sees in the transfiguration that the whole Christian life is about transformation into Christ. Prayer leads to transforming communion with God. Not only Jesus, but also his disciples will need this profound, prayerful heartening to sustain them on the journey and beyond. Their journey of discipleship holds the promise of sharing the transfiguring life of God. The Messiah comes to serve, not to be served and to give his life as a ransom for many. This Lent the first disciple calls us to renew our own lifelong journey into Jesus' Pascal Mystery.
