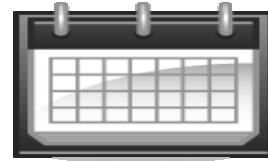

On April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II declared this Second Sunday of Easter to be called "Divine Mercy Sunday". During His conversations with St. Faustina in Poland in the early 1930's, Jesus asked her to "**tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy...I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, especially for poor sinners...The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion (on that day) shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment...On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open.**" Today is that day! As long as we are in the state of grace, Confession within a reasonable time is sufficient. Let us pray together.
