

2nd Collection for June 23 and 24 Mission Appeal Diocese of Meru

Diocese of Meru is located on the Eastern Province of Kenya, Africa. It is one of the 26 Catholic Dioceses in Kenya. The local Ordinary is Rt. Rev. Saleius Mugambi, the 3rd Bishop since the Diocese was born. The Catholic faith was brought to Meru by the Consolata Missionaries from Turin - Italy in 1911. The Diocese of Meru is made up of seven Deaneries. Diocese of Meru had 126 Diocesan priests, 46 religious priest, 25 religious brothers, 299 Religious sisters, 640 cathechists, 500 minor Seminarians and 88 major seminarians who are in various major Seminaries in the country. There are total of 55 parishes and several Catholic institutions within the Diocese. A few Diocesan priests serve as 'fidei Donum' in other diocese within the country while a few are outside the country too. One feature to note is that the Equator crosses across the Diocese and about 60% of Diocese is semi-arid.

Generally majority of people hold firm to their faith and therefore are active members of the church despite of the poverty they languish in.

Hope this short information is helpful to you in giving and you have an idea of the Diocese.
