Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday, all three readings are related. Our closing song expresses their common theme: "We Are Called." Whether we feel up to the task or not, our baptism calls us to be Christ's presence in our world. It's this world where his compassionate presence is needed - our world of home, family, work, school, neighborhood in San Bruno or Millbrae. Yes, there are depressing articles in the daily news and yes, life is more complicated than it was when most of us were young, but God has not given up on us and never will! So we need to not give up on God's plan for humanity. God's desire is clear through Jesus' life and subsequent Catholic Social Teaching: that every human being have his or her basic needs met - life, food, clothing, shelter, meaningful work for a just wage and relationships which are lifegiving and healthy. Our lives are all intertwined, as our housing catastrophe and the European debt crisis have proven. Our ignoring of climate change directly affects our neighbors in low-lying areas like Papua New Guinea and Bangladesh, as well as our country's coastlands.

Ephesians 13-14 expresses beautifully the wonder of our call. It might even give us the courage to take seriously God's choice of us, imperfect human beings that we are. This reading also speaks of God's plan to have all things "in heaven and on earth" summed up in Christ. Fr. Pierre Teilhard de Chardin, SJ spoke of this in his writings and, as a prophet ahead of his times, was initially condemned. The Church as well as evolutionary biologists and futurists have come to recognize his wisdom. Why not give this passage a prayerful reading? Peace.




