"We know God in the breaking of the bread, and we are not alone any more. Heaven is a banquet and life is a banquet, too, even with a crust, where there is companionship." (Dorothy Day).

Yesterday was the Feast of St. Clare who had profound devotion to the Eucharist and whose companionship with her Sisters, the Poor Clares, radically changed community life for women. It has been 800 years since the 18 year old left her wealthy family and the marriage arranged for her to follow a bedraggled Francis whose preaching of the gospel captured her heart. There are many legends about her life, but some facts are indisputable. She felt called to a contemplative life of prayer and penance and desired, above all, to follow the poor and crucified Christ. She argued with successive Popes for what she called "the privilege of poverty," refusing the Benedictine rule which they tried in vain to foist upon her. She insisted that her community would own nothing and live on the generosity of the food given by the local people. She was forced to take the title of Abbess, but infused it with a new egalitarian meaning: all the nuns were equal regardless of their familial status and there was shared decision-making in her rule, practices unheard of at that time. She washed the feet of the nuns who begged and did the most menial tasks herself. She was so stubborn that, although she was often ill from too much fasting, she refused to die until her rule - the first written by a woman - was approved. She also had the gift of healing which drew many to the San Damiano convent.

Clare's life was changed because she really heard the Word of God which Francis preached and lived. What would it take for me to let the Word of God this weekend change some aspect of my life? Am I able to "be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven [me] in Christ"? May the Spirit guide us all.



EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS NEEDED


