Dear Friends,

Forty years ago today, Gene and I stood before the altar here at St. Robert's. We vowed to: "love and cherish each other till death do us part". Now, I sit here in Gene's big blue chair, sipping his favorite Hawaiian Pineapple tea. Glancing at today's readings, I experience a twinge of sadness. I can no longer look into Gene's twinkling blue eyes; nor be reassured by his encouraging smile and the strength of his hand holding mine. I would be so happy to hear his cheerful "Hi, Honey, I'm home!"

I gaze beyond our living room window and see the cloudless, blue sky and shimmering rays of the sun. Two sail boats skim the calm waters of San Francisco Bay. The tall pines and eucalyptus gently sway in the breeze. I quietly thank God for the beauty of His creation. As if on cue, a white butterfly comes to rest on Gene's wisteria vine; pauses for a moment; then flutters by. Our Father so often gifts me with his butterfly to let me know that Gene is still with me! Death cannot part us! My moment of sorrow lifts --- I once again experience joy.

Today St. James says to us: "All good giving and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no alteration or shadow caused by change." One way to show our love for God is to open our hearts to Him; accept His love and every good gift from above. God wants us to receive His love; love Him in return; love ourselves and love everyone who comes into our lives. When we receive graciously, we are able to give graciously.

God's perfect gift to Gene and me is the life that we share. Though so much has changed within these almost three years since Gene went to heaven, there is one thing that will never change--- God's light lives within each us---forever joining us together. When I focus on the words of St. James and let them seep into my soul, peace, hope and joy return. God brought Gene and me together for a reason. Then and now, God is with us. His Holy Spirit is guiding protecting and loving me all the way home, where we will be together for all eternity! Once again, I pray: "Thank God for Gene May!"


