

Would that the LORD might bestow his spirit on them all!

With these exhortations, Moses expressed a longing for all of God's people to receive the same Spirit of prophecy that he had been given, and which the Lord had just shared with the 72 elders of Israel. Two of the 72 selected as elders were absent from the main event – not refusing to join, but accepting responsibility for remaining with the camp. Mere geographic separation could not deter the grace conferred on the elders from reaching its intended recipients. Only a willful rejection of that gift could be an effective obstacle to that grace.

From Moses' lips to God's ear, as the saying goes – bestowing on the elders a share of Moses' spirit of prophecy prefigures Baptism, through which God unites people with Christ and bestows on them a share of Christ's prophetic Spirit. Immersed in the Living Word through scripture and lives of service (and empowered by the grace of our Baptism), we, too, can bear God's Word in our hearts and on our lips. May it fill us with joy to embrace the gift and the call, that through word and deed our very lives might become – for each other and for the world – prophetic proclamations of the Gospel, effective witnesses to God's love, and humble instruments of God's arace.


