Dear Friends.

Out here on our deck, the sun is shining and the sky is blue. The autumn breeze is invigorating, but a bit chilly. I'm glad I have my cup of Hawaiian Pineapple tea on the table beside me. I'm waiting for Gene's white butterfly to appear as it has so many, many times during these three years since Gene went to heaven. I try to concentrate on today's readings...but I am distracted. One thought keeps drifting in and out of my head: Words are so very powerful - either for good or for evil. Jesus' words bring us hope and strength when we take the time to listen to them. Today's Psalm tells us: "Upright is the word of the Lord, and all His works are trustworthy. He loves justice and right; of the kindness of the Lord the earth is full." Words of kindness and encouragement to and from one another are faith-building - community-building -love-building. Words of comfort to someone who is grieving the loss of a loved one help to lighten their sorrow and pain. Words of love gladden our hearts. These are the words we need to speak to one another; the words we need to hear from one another.

October is Respect Life Month and also National Anti-Bullying Month. Both of these focuses deal with respecting and protecting the lives of others. Statistic show that 160,000 children miss school every day because of verbal or physical harassment; 58% of teens have had hurtful things said to them online. Sad to say, some adults are also guilty of such destructive behavior by being critical, judgmental and by spreading rumors. If children don't learn how to live God's law of love by the good example of their parents, how can bullying be stopped!

I remember one evening sitting with our children at the dinner table. I can hear Gene ask: "How was your day?" One of them immediately went into a tirade about how terrible someone had acted at school; what a horrible person he or she was. Gene listened until our child ran out of steam. He quietly said: "If you can't say something nice about someone; say nothing at all! We don't know why a person acts the way they do. Talking against another can cause terrible harm. We need to think before we speak. Once hateful words leave our lips (or fingertips) they can never be taken back." These are the words of a wise and loving man spoken to our children and to those of us who, with the help of God, are never too old to change. As if on cue, here comes Gene's white butterfly!


