Dear Friends,

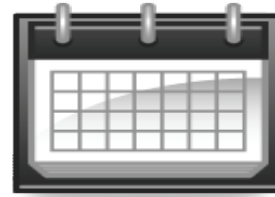
I'm sitting here on our deck, enjoying the warmth of the sun on this glorious day in May – the day that God, Our Father, has made. As I sip my Vanilla Chai tea, I scan today's readings. Then ask Gene to help me compose this letter to you. This is Trinity Sunday. The Holy Trinity is a mystery which our finite minds are unable to comprehend. Our God is not a "one-person god"; He is One God, Who possesses three distinct, individual Divine Persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Our belief in the Holy Trinity is by faith alone. In this Year of Faith, let us ask the Holy Spirit to help us to fully accept that which we cannot understand and open our hearts that we may fully believe. St. Patrick explained this mystery to my Irish ancestors by showing them a shamrock – one stem with three petals. They believed and, because of their faith, I too believe. (Out of the blue, a little white butterfly flutters past me and lands on Gene's wild red rose bush.)

What I do know is that God (Who is Love) could not have just one person within His being. He needed another person to love. As Proverbs tells us today: ***"I was His delight day by day, playing before Him all the while, playing on the surface of His earth; and I found delight in the sons of men."*** God the Father is our Creator and the Creator of all that exists. Jesus is His Beloved Son, Who became one like us in all ways but sin. Jesus taught us how to live and how to love. For Him, living and loving are one and the same, since He is Love. He has told us: ***"I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep."*** Jesus loves us so much that He died for us so that our sins might be forgiven and we would be reconciled to the Father; thus we will live forever with Him in Heaven. The Holy Spirit (the Third Person of the Trinity) is the Love between the Father and the Son. He is our Advocate, Sanctifier and Teacher. As St. Paul tells us today: ***"The love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us."*** This one God, in all three Persons, came to live within us the moment we were baptized. How very deeply loved are we – loved by the Holy Trinity -- for all eternity!
