Will there be enough?

That worry seems to confront us in so many times and places, life can start to feel like one of those classic Tex Avery cartoons (where a fugitive from the law can't seem to get away from Droopy the dog, because the canine deputy pops up seemingly everywhere). The depth and breadth of problems around us are sometimes so overwhelming, it can seem like there is no hope of ever overcoming them. We are bombarded by news about human violence, oppression, and betrayal ... about natural disasters and mortal threats, and we hunger for relief. Our spirits sometimes wobble from weakness for need of nourishment.

In the miraculous feeding of five thousand followers recounted by the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus satisfies a physical hunger beyond the worldly means of the disciples to meet, as a sign to accompany God's promise to feed the spiritual hunger of those who seek Him. More is conveyed in this story than could fit in this short reflection; but one important point it makes to us is that the food Jesus gives in the Sacrament of his Body and Blood is not just adequate to satisfy the spiritual hunger of Jesus' followers – it is enough to feed the whole world's needs, and still have an overflowing surplus afterward.

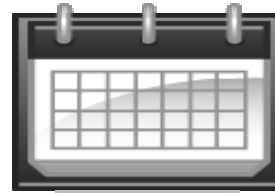
When our hope falters in response to the overwhelming material and spiritual need around us – and within us, take to heart that God's grace will be enough to heal, redeem, and feed the seemingly inexhaustible need of the world and our own hearts. It will be more than enough.
