The universal Church has been marking the 50th anniversary of Vatican II which took place in several month segments from 1962 through 1965. One of the many great insights the bishops and cardinals gave us is the sense that all the baptized are called to holiness. We hear this in Paul's letter to the Galatians today: "I have been crucified with Christ, yet I live no longer, but Christ lives in me."
