Who Do The People Say that I am?

Jesus once asked His disciples who did people say that He was? There were a variety of opinions. Some said He had come to prepare the way for the Messiah, some thought He was a prophet, still others thought He was John the Baptist come back to life. No one, however, said He was the Son of God. That was too much for them to believe.

This is the reason Jesus tells them not to tell anyone about their vision of Him in today's gospel until He has risen from the dead. They can't truly believe He is the Son of God until He proves it by rising from the dead. It is only then that Thomas says to Jesus "You are my Lord and God."

There are many opinions about Jesus today ranging from seeing Him as a myth to proclaiming Him as the Divine Son of God. Things haven't changed very much. Jesus is still controversial, and many believe but many do not.

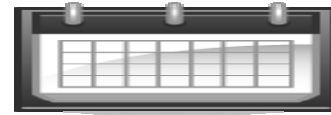
