High school students call the Religious Education Office.

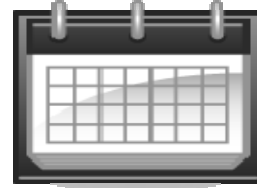

Dear Parishioners,

I can still remember a sermon I heard on Mother's Day - on this occasion of honoring mothers, the preacher suggested that the intimacy between a mother and her very young child is so profound that one cannot call them two separate people. Yet, a mother and a child are not one person either, they are some mystical number in between. That is what Jesus is saying as he bids farewell to his frightened disciples, panicked about how they will continue in his absence. He says of his relationship with God and with them, " I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you -- the pervasive and connecting power of the Holy Spirit will keep them forever close. Where the disciples fear separation, Jesus speaks of continuity. Even today, as he sits at the right hand of His Father, Jesus is still fully God and fully man. He remains bone of our bone and flesh of our flesh -- for all of eternity. This means that Almighty God has experienced everything we have experienced or will experience -- all of our joys, and all of our sufferings, all of our hopes and all our disappointments, all of our successes and all of our failures. Since He is still us in every way Jesus remains an ever-- present door of hope for the church, a river of consolation for the discouraged and downcast, and a pathway to the Father for those who seek him. He is our great high priest, the one mediator between God and the human race -- Jesus wants his disciples to know that He will be available to them in new ways after His death. Thanks to the pervasive power of God's love, there is no where His friends can go where God is not, and no where they can go where the Spirit is not, or where Christ is not -- they are free to spend their days in their mission, rather than simply clinging to the relationship that was.

You have probably noticed that during Mass the celebrant is inviting those bringing Communion to the homebound or hospitals to come up after we've all received Communion. If you have a family member or neighbor who cannot come to Mass, you can either call Sr. Patricia at 589-0104 and ask her to have one of the Eucharistic Ministers bring Communion or you can bring the person Holy Communion yourself. You just need to have a small container, called a pyx, into which the host can be placed. Please see Sr. Sheral or one of the priests before Mass begins.
