Dear Friends,

I sit here on our deck, sipping pineapple tea, meditating on today's readings. So quiet and peaceful is Gene's garden. Here it is that I take shelter, as does Elijah in his cave. The Lord says to him, "Go outside and stand on the mountain before the Lord; the Lord will be passing by." God is not in the strong wind; nor in the earthquake; nor in the fire. God is in the tiny whispering sound.

Do we expect Our Lord to come to us in a dramatic way, or maybe not come to us at all? The Almighty One, is our gentle, merciful, loving Father. He truly cares about us. All we need do is spend some quiet time with Him; open our heart to Him; speak to Him -- then wait for His tiny whisper. God is not way up there; He is right here – His Holy Spirit truly does live within each of us.

In today's Gospel, Jesus goes up to the mountain (His shelter) by Himself to pray. He speaks with His Father and listens to Him. His friends are in their boat, tossed about by the wind and waves. Suddenly they see Jesus walking toward them on the sea. They are terrified! He tells them: "Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid." The impulsive Peter asks Jesus to let him come to Him on the water. After his first step, fear overcomes him; Peter begins to sink. He cries out to Jesus: "Lord, save me". Jesus stretches out His hand and catches Peter.

Like Peter, we often encounter seemingly insurmountable challenges. Like Peter, all we need do is cry out to Jesus: "Lord, save me". Jesus will hear us; stretch out His hand to us and catch us.

Feast of the Assumption


