Dear Parishioners,

Most of us don't enjoy pain and suffering, and to be honest, don't relish the idea of helping someone in the midst of their suffering either. Yet this is one aspect of what Palm Sunday is about. Those of us who were reared Catholics know the readings almost by heart. We hear one of the Suffering Servant passages from Isaiah, then the Philippians reading expressing the almost unbelievable mystery of the Son of God becoming one of us and surrendering his life out of love for us. Lest we think this wasn't such an awful thing, the Passion invites us to enter into what he experienced as the human being he was. Betrayal, abandonment, a sense of failure – who of us hasn't experienced the sorrow those feelings bring? He gives of himself totally and freely as he does daily in the Eucharist and he invites us to do the same.

Who among our family, co-workers or friends needs our help in carrying a cross of loneliness, grief or chronic illness? Might today be the day we reach out with compassion? Today, we add our Rice Bowl offerings to assist the Catholic Relief Services staff as they respond in the name of U. S. Catholics to the needs of 100 million of our global family, those who are still bearing the cross of poverty, hunger and war.

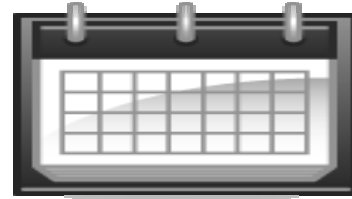
