Dear Parishioners,

On this Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, we have a wonderful reminder of something many of us older folks learned as children. I don't recall what the question was in the catechism, but I distinctly remember that the answer was that "we are made in the image and likeness of God." As a child, we probably didn't have a clue what that meant; but as adults, it is both a blessing and an invitation! The blessing is that amazingly we share in the divine nature of our God! We can imitate the Father's life-giving creativity; the Son's laying down his life and experiencing fuller life by our generosity; and the Spirit's guidance by our wise counsel to those who are confused or wandering. With all our idiosyncrasies and faults, we are made in the image of God.

The invitation comes from the reality that our God is "three persons in one God" as we also learned as children. Another way to express this is that our God is a community of persons. Members of communities share their presence and their assistance with each other, especially in times of joy and sorrow. They accept each other's differences and forgive each other. They collaborate on projects or issues that they care about. One of the great joys of being here at St. Robert's is that many of us recognize that we belong to our parish community, as well as one of our many smaller communities formed by bonds of friendship. Why not take a few moments this week to think about the grace of being made in the image of God? Who do you consider part of your community here? Who among the members of our global community do you include in your prayers? May the Spirit of God deepen our joy and our gratitude in being who we are!

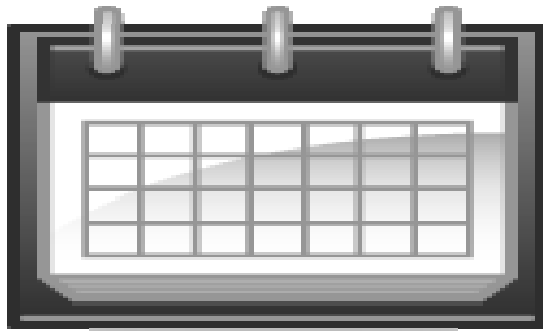
