Dear Parishioners,

The powerful readings this weekend move us toward the ending of the Church's liturgical year. Every year we are reminded that one day we will all die and will need to give an account of our actions. Our society doesn't encourage us to talk about death or to face the fact that none of us will live forever in this life, but the Church does. During the month of November, this time of harvest and completion, the names of those who've gone before us have surrounded us. We've prayed for All Souls, those persons awaiting their entry into the glory of heaven, and for All Saints, those holy women and men who've "made it." They are enjoying the presence of our God, "like the stars forever" and we hope to join them when our turn comes.

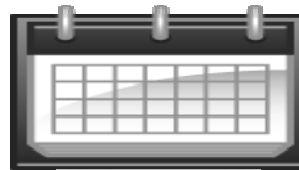
We heard that we too are called to be saints, people whose lives mirror that of Jesus by living the values of his gospel. In one of the readings for last Monday's Mass, St. Paul addresses the Corinthians and ourselves: "Do you not know that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? ...For the temple of God, which you are, is holy." When he was with us in September and consistently, Pope Francis has spelled out what having the Spirit of God within us involves: welcoming the stranger and the immigrant; assisting the homeless and the poor; including all those who feel left out or marginalized; showing mercy to those condemned by society. May the Spirit continue to change our hearts so that when the hour of our own death arrives, we may greet the Lord's coming with eagerness and peace. S. Seral

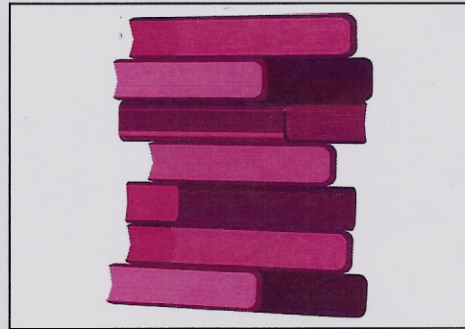
