THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

The Baptism of Jesus marks the end of the Christmas Season for the Church. Long before Christmas Day was celebrated as Jesus' birthday, His birth, the visit of the three kings and His baptism were celebrated together on January 6th, The Feast of the Epiphany.
