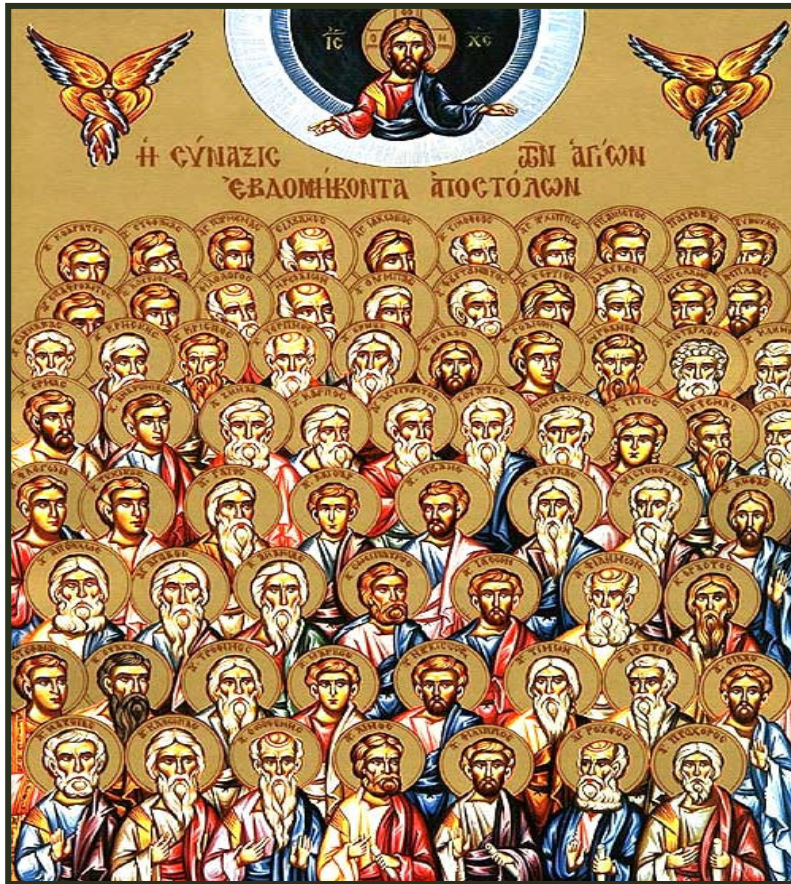

We welcome Fr. Tony to our parish family and we are grateful to his new ministry here. A welcome reception in his honor will be announced later in July.

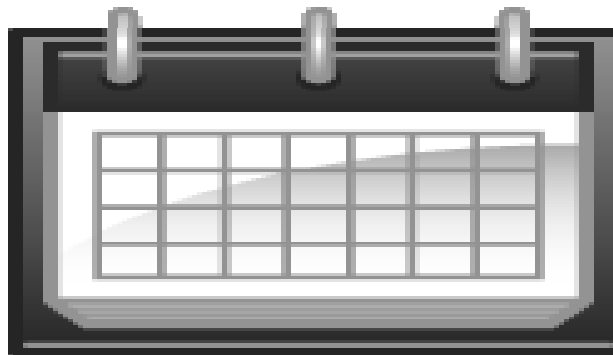
