Adult confirmation is available on an individual basis. Please contact the rectory to make arrangements.

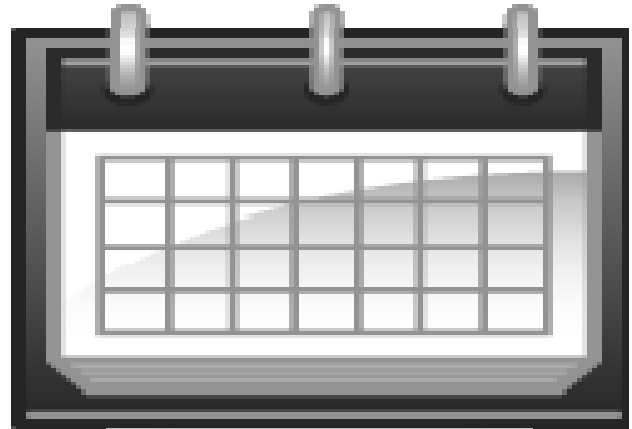
Dear Parishioners,

We hear the gospel today of the Good Samaritan with its key question, "And who is my neighbor?" Just over a year ago, Pope Francis issued his marvelous encyclical on climate change, "Laudato Si" which answers that question. He clearly calls each of us as well as international, national and religious leaders to make the major adjustments necessary in our consumer lifestyles. The present global situation is already stark: unprecedented droughts have caused one million people in Vietnam and 18 million in Ethiopia to be in urgent need of food aid due to El Nino and climate change. In Fiji, 50,000 are homeless from a super-cyclone and closer to home, climate refugees from Louisiana are being resettled due to rising tides. According to the United Nations, 50 to 200 million people could be displaced by 2050 because of climate change.

So what can we do? As the Holy Father has said, "The family is where we are formed as people. Every family is a brick in the building of society." So let's begin close at home, perhaps reminding each other to adopt the Native American wisdom of thinking of our decision's effect on the seventh generation from now. I gladly sort through garbage to rescue the recyclables, because I don't want someone decades from now asking me, "What part of 'reduce, reuse, recycle' didn't you understand?" If we have fruit trees in our yards, we might share the produce with our Catholic Worker or with neighbors on a tight budget. Why not ask our families how they'd like us to respond to Pope Francis' invitation?
