Dear Parishioners,

What a week this has been! On Sept. 1, Pope Francis announced a season of Care for Creation beginning then and continuing through the Feast of St. Francis, Oct. 4. As he did in the encyclical "Laudato Si", the Holy Father wants to promote environmental justice, concern for the poor and responsible social commitments. "May the present Jubilee of Mercy summon the Christian faithful to 'profound interior conversion' (Laudato Si, 217)... which requires a clear recognition of our responsibility to ourselves, our neighbors, creation and the Creator." Sounding very much like Mother Teresa whom he canonized on Sept. 4, he invites us to pray, "O God of the poor, help us to rescue the abandoned and forgotten of this earth who are so precious in your eyes."

Among those abandoned and forgotten are surely immigrants and refugees. You'll recall that on April 16, the pope brought three Muslim Syrian refugee families back with him from Lesbos, Greece. We may not be aware that we are still detaining hundreds of the Central American refugees who arrived in the summer of 2014, escaping the violence of drug smugglers, gangs and extreme poverty. Mostly mothers and children, paying smugglers to get them from the three most dangerous countries, Honduras, Guatemala and El Salvador, to the safety of the United States. Our bishops have repeatedly visited the three detention centers in Texas and Pennsylvania and petitioned our government to stop detaining them. The centers have minimal services and no educational opportunities for the children. The further trauma they experience is unnecessary and lacking lawyers, they are much less likely to win their justifiable asylum cases. As the Pope has said, "Refugees are not numbers, they are people who have faces, names, stories, and need to be treated as such."

As we observe the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of 9/11, let us pray for all those who died that day and everyone who has died from terrorism. May they rest in peace. S. Sheral




