Dear Friends,

As I sit here in Gene's big blue chair, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, I remember Martin Luther King, Jr. whose life we celebrate today. Gene and I were greatly influenced by this Baptist minister who played a key role in the American Civil Rights Movement. He opened our eyes to the prejudice and racial discrimination we, who call ourselves Christians, were perpetrating against so many of our sisters and brothers. For most of us, indifference was the way in which we closed our eyes to how very unfair we and our country treated these precious sons and daughters of our Heavenly Father, whom He created in His image and likeness. Though some progress has been made, we still have a long way to go.

Each person, regardless of their color, gender, religion or race was **"chosen in Christ before the world began"**. Each of us is a reflection of our Creator. Christianity is meant to be a loving way of life. Churches must find the central cause for their commitment to justice and to the struggle for the equality, human rights and dignity of every person from the first moment of conception until natural death.

As individuals we must try to influence the attitude of others by rejecting racial stereotypes, racial slurs and derogatory racial jokes. We need to be sensitive to, and talk to our children about, the authentic human values and cultural contributions of each racial group in our country. As God's creation, we are all one. There is no you or me or them; there is just us. Let us see the Face of Jesus in every man, woman and child; love them and treat them as we would Jesus, for each of us is precious in God's eyes and each is a beloved child of God.

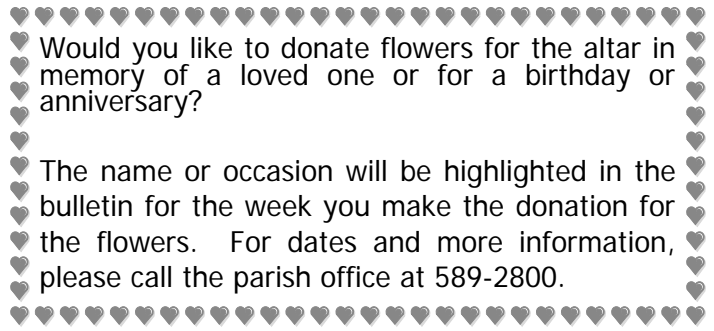
