Dear Friends,

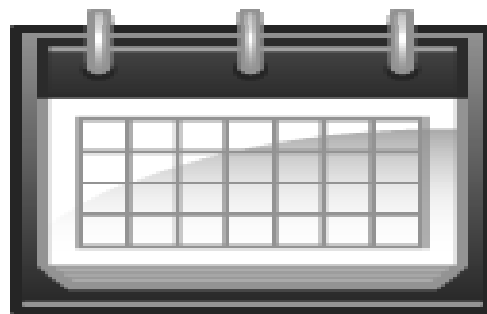
Here I sit in Gene's big blue chair, sipping Hawaiian Pineapple tea. Yesterday was the World Day of the Sick. Those who are ill and in pain are my inspiration. They are People of Courage – my heroes. Watching my husband, Gene, graciously dealing with Waldenstrom's (a rare cancer of the blood) for the 12 years following his diagnosis, showed me the meaning of true faith and courage.

Can we put ourselves in the place of one such person who is in the midst of constant, debilitating pain. What is it like to open your eyes each morning, expecting your pain to be gone? Then you see that walker on the floor beside your bed. Your pain is still there! You shout out: "I can't do this any more. When, O Jesus, when will You touch and heal me?" If you are able, you force yourself to get out of bed and begin another long, exhausting day – still hoping; still praying that He will take your pain away.

There are good people in our lives for whom this is their daily existence. Their only consolation is that Jesus' Spirit lives within them, loving them and giving them the strength to go on. What can we do to help? We can pray for their healing; visit them; call them on the phone; send them a note or card letting them know that we care about them – that we love them. We can offer to sit beside them, giving their care-givers a bit of a rest. Those who take care of a hurting loved one are our heroes too. They also suffer the anguish of seeing the person they love in pain and not being able to take it away. Jesus, please let these beautiful sisters and brothers of Yours who are ill and their care-givers experience Your Loving Presence within them. Renew their hope that **"All things are possible with God."**

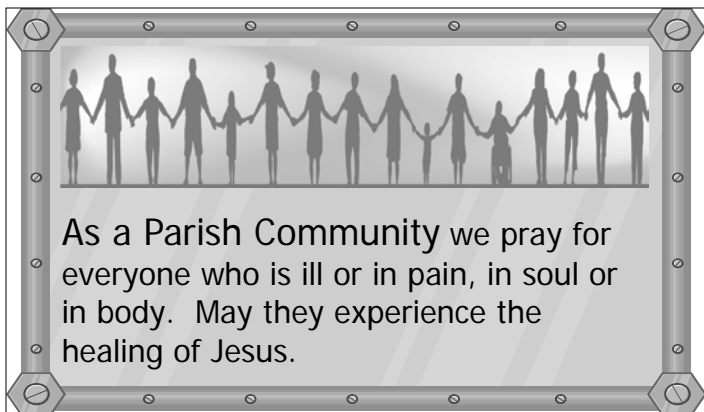
