

Dear Parishioners,

The readings this weekend are lovely and challenging as well. Walter Wink, a noted Protestant biblical scholar, has an insightful understanding of the Jesus' teachings to his listeners, most likely the poor. I'll pass on his explanation of two of Jesus' examples. Indebtedness was a huge problem in the time of Jesus. A man was terribly in debt if he had lost all his possessions and had nothing to give the person suing him except his outer garment! Jesus says he should also give him his undergarments! In their culture at that time, the naked person didn't experience shame, but those who looked on him did. So Jesus is enabling the poor man to keep his dignity and humiliating the one who is so demanding!

The Romans were an occupying force in those days and in order to limit the abuse of the "locals" by the soldiers, the soldier was only allowed to have a Palestinian carry his load for one mile. Can't you imagine a poor man arguing with the soldier to carry his load an extra mile, thus forcing him to break the law? The ordinary people who heard Jesus' speak must have smiled at Jesus' comments!

Of course, the other half of Jesus' teaching is very challenging. To love the way the Father has loved us takes a lifetime of trying, apologizing when we fail, and trying again. May the Spirit guide us to keep trusting and loving as much as we can!


