PARISH MUSIC MINISTRY – **589-2800** Mr. Kevin Imbimbo Dear Parishioners,

Isn't the Church wise to give us 50 days to unpack the wonder of the resurrection after the mere 40 days of Lent? Our Lenten practices helped us make room for the Holy Spirit to work on those behaviors and attitudes that needed changing in us, but we don't want to get stuck focusing on them. The emptiness of our church was transformed by the beauty and scent of the flowers, the echoing Alleluias and the majesty of the Paschal Candle, the Light of Christ.

We shared in the new life promised us by Christ's resurrection and symbolized by the renewal of our baptismal promises. We rejoiced with our newly baptized and confirmed adults, the fruit of much searching and eight months of prayer, conversation and learning.

So what happens now? The first reading this weekend from the Acts of the Apostles gives us the response: We're called, as the first followers were, to "breaking bread," their term for the Eucharist: to meeting together in parish groups (and at nearby grocery stores); and to sharing what we have with those in need. We're not perfect yet and probably never will be, so it's good to remember that, even though the disciples ran away in their fear on Good Friday, Jesus repeated words to them are "Peace be with you." May we let the Easter peace we experience be our gift to those we live with and everyone we encounter! Sr. Sheral


### Children's Liturgy Needs Your Help!


