Dear Parishioners,

This weekend all three of the readings have a clear message for us. The first one from the Acts of the Apostles is a great model of what to do when we feel that our needs aren't being met. The Greek speakers complain to the Twelve that their widows aren't being included in "the daily distribution" of food. So the leaders ask members of this group to choose those who can do that necessary task. They choose seven good men and the apostles then commission them. We're blest here at St. Robert's to have organizations of parishioners responding to the needs of just about all the various groups in the parish and our area.

The second reading from St. Peter reminds us of our dignity. We are "a chosen race, a royal priesthood a holy nation, a people of his own, so that you may announce the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light." What a marvelous reminder when our own individual faults and failings may make us wonder if we can do anything right! We have been blessed with faith in the Lord and the gifts of hope and charity to brighten our sometimes dark and confusing world.

John's gospel also lifts us up. Even when we are grieving the loss of someone close to us, we know in our bones that our loved one is now resting in the arms of God. The song, "Where My Father Lives" reminds us that "In my Father's house, there is room for all...And a place for you will be waiting there. Come to me, I will bring you home."

Happy Mother's Day to all our Moms and Grandmothers! And to everyone who has loved us like a mother and helped us become who we are!

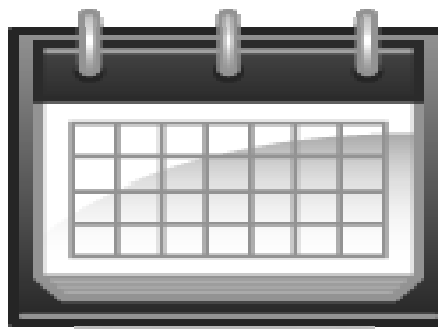
