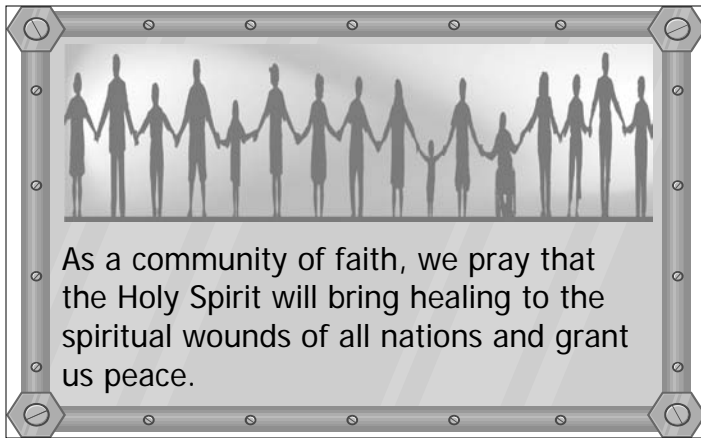
St. Anthony's
