YOU SATISFY THE HUNGRY HEART

During the persecution of the church in Russia, a small group of Catholics were imprisoned in Siberia. They were assigned to work in a coal mine. Starving and overworked, they still managed to save a few raisins which they used to make a kind of wine and a few scraps of bread. Hungry for the Eucharist, they gathered in the dead of night in the mine and a fellow prisoner who was a priest celebrated Mass with them. They were starving for the Eucharist, and despite the terrible conditions they lived in, they found comfort and strength in that underground Mass.

Jesus, who promised to be with us always, was with them during their trials, as they remembered his Passion, Death, and Resurrection.

How about us? We can be spiritually starving and not even know it. We can go to Mass every Sunday and not even be fed.

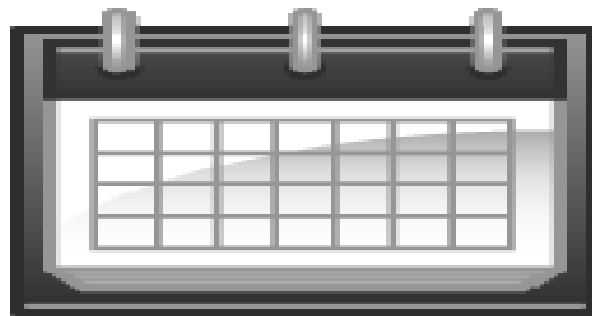
