

## Dear Friends,

Sitting here on Gene's deck, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, I remember that day 45 years ago yesterday, standing before the altar at St. Robert's, exchanging our marriage vows. The first evening we met, I could tell that Gene was a totally optimistic man with a twinkle in his eyes; a wide-open, cheerful smile and an oh-so kind heart. Through our 37 years together, his positive mental attitude prevailed. Each day I thank God for Gene May!

Every morning, Gene would awaken, look out our window and sing: "Oh What A Beautiful Morning". Many a day as he worked around our home. I'd hear him singing "You've Got To Accentuate The Positive: Eliminate The Negative; Latch Onto The Affirmative: and Don't Mess With Mister-In-Between". This is the way Gene enjoyed each day of his life. Though experiencing 12 years of cancer of the blood and 83 blood transfusions, no one would ever know that he wasn't completely healthy. He kept on doing what he had always done attending 8:30 Mass each morning and living as he had always lived.

How did Gene remain in this state of positivity? It isn't that he hadn't experienced hardships, heartache, pain or loss of loved ones. It is Gene's attitude that kept him the peaceful, joyful, funny, lover-of-life that God created him to be. Gene trusted and loved His God and everyone God sent into his life. We too can live this way. Though negativity tries to overwhelm us, we can pray as does today's Psalm: "You are my help, and in the shadow of your wings I shout for joy. My soul clings fast to you; your right hand upholds me." Let's remember that our God loves us; He is in charge and nothing can happen unless He allows it. When bad things do happen, Jesus continues to hold us tightly in His arms. He will

never leave us for He lives deep within us, loving, protecting and guiding us all the days of our life. As Gene so often said to us:




