Dear Parishioners,

Today is the third time we hear about vineyards in the readings. In the gospel, the vineyard is Israel; the tenants, the religious leaders; the series of servants, the prophets; the son, Jesus the Messiah; his murder the crucifixion. But as Jude Siciliano, a Dominican theologian reminds us, we must be careful "not to heap blame on the Jews for not accepting Christ, the owner's son." The kingdom, God's new vineyard, "has been entrusted to all of us, parents, teachers, volunteers, ordained ministers, etc...We must live the gospel as faithfully as we can and, through our lives, make Christ present everywhere.

Another reflection on the gospel by Michael Simone, SJ in -America magazine raises two excellent questions for us: What work has God called you to do in his vineyard? How do you remember that the vineyard is God's, not yours?

Clarissa Pinkola Estes, the author of Women Who Run with the Wolves also offers us wisdom in this time of great need and many tragedies:

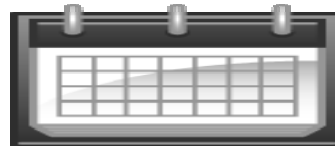
*Didn't you say you were a believer? Didn't you say you pledged to listen to a voice greater? Didn't you ask for grace? Don't you remember that to be in grace means to submit to the voice greater? Ours is not the task of fixing the entire world all at once, but of stretching out to mend the part of the world that is within our reach. Any small, calm thing that one soul can do to help another soul, to assist some portion of this poor suffering world, will help immensely. It is not given to us to know which acts or by whom, will cause the critical mass to tip toward an enduring good.*

If there are a few moments of quiet in your busy day, you might ask the Spirit to guide you to a fitting response. May God bless and keep us all.

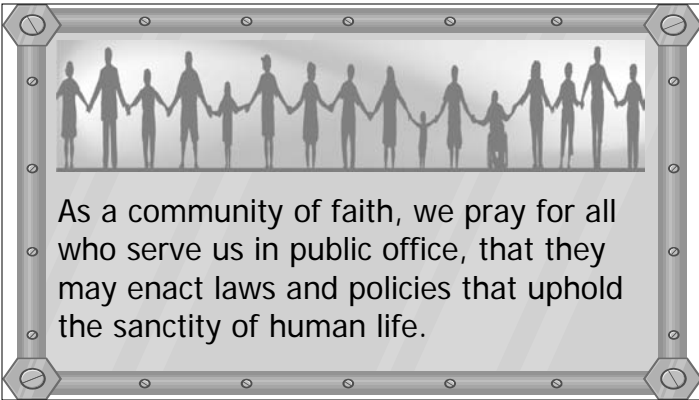
### **October is Respect Life Month**

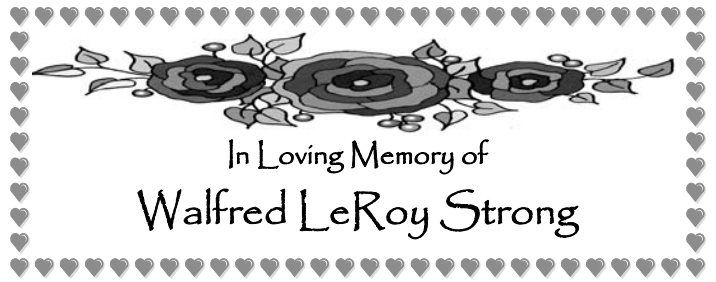
