Dear Parishioners,

Last week's gospel was a bit confusing about the coin and whether to pay the census tax or not. If Jesus says to pay it, the Jewish people would be angry, since they were under oppression by the Romans and want their freedom. If he says not to, the Romans could accuse him of fomenting rebellion and he's in trouble. In the monthly resource, "Give Us This Day", Fr. James Wallace, a Redemptorist preacher, explains, "Repay to Caesar what belongs to him" - the coin with his image on it. "Repay to God what belongs to God" - the human person stamped with God's image.

I bring this up because it relates to this Sunday's readings. The Exodus passage is unbelievably clear: The Jewish people need to be respectful and caring to those we might call "the least of our brothers and sisters": widows and orphans (totally dependent on men in that patriarchal society) and undocumented persons. Even when a poor person borrows money from you, you must not keep his cloak overnight as collateral because he needs it to sleep in.

The Pharisees ask Jesus about the greatest commandment and he answers what we all grew up with: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. The whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments."

In this time of such great need in so many parts of the world and in our state, making the connections between these two commandments is essential. Some of our parishioners are barely making ends meet; their families and their needs must come first. But what about the rest of us who have enough to cover our basic needs? What do we do with our "extra" money? Do we have to buy one more pair of pants or shoes if we really have enough already? Have we figured out, as we probably tell our children, the difference between what we want and what we need?

May the Holy Spirit guide us as we do our best to follow these two great commandments!

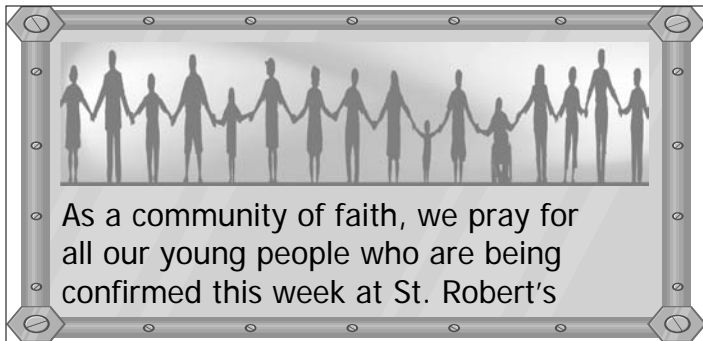


