Dear Friends,

I sit here in Gene's big blue chair, sipping Vanilla Chai tea, as I study today's readings. I especially love the Gospel of John, where Jesus tells us: "***I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and mine know me...A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.***"

Several years ago, while attending a meeting of parents at St. Monica's, we were told that a CCD class would be starting for pre-schoolers). Surprisingly, I found myself volunteering to teach the class. Shirley, my oldest, was 4 years old. The little ones listened intently as I told them the story of "The Good Shepherd" and how He loved and protected His lambs and sheep. Each of them smiled when Jesus left the 99 to go and find the one little lamb that had gotten away.

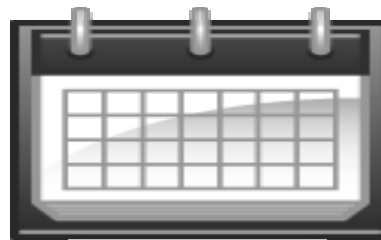
On our drive back home to my Mom and Dad's house (where we had come to live when my first husband Clarence died), Shirley said to me: "Mommy, that Good Shepherd is just like my Grandpa." She was so right. My Dad and my Mom, without a moment's hesitation, took Shirley (3 years old), Grant (a year old) and Jeannie (11 days before she was born) and me into their home to shepherd us, take care of us and keep us safe from harm. Shirley was so right: Jesus and Dad have the same big, loving, merciful heart. Both of them would lay down their lives for us.

***"My sheep hear My voice; I know them, and they follow Me."*** My Dad heard the voice of Jesus and acted upon it. Like the Good Shepherd did for His flock, my Dad fed us; gave us a warm, safe home and the security that he and my Mom would always be there for us. Jesus feeds us with His own Body and Blood in the Eucharist. Each time we receive Him in Holy Communion, we grow more and more like Jesus. As time goes by, we too give of ourselves to others and would lay down our lives for them.
