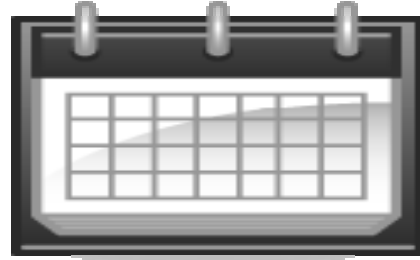
The readings today might remind us of Pope Francis' encyclical, "Laudato Si" on the wonders of creation and our responsibility to care for every aspect of it. In the gospel, Jesus talks about the kingdom of God and how it begins teeny like the mustard seed, but grows so large! Though summer is obviously not a liturgical season, perhaps this reading might invite us to take some time to reflect on our own growth in faith. (I write this realizing that with children home from school, for many of you, summer is a more hectic time rather than a slower one!)

Is there a place in my home or apartment where I could arrange a place for reflection, perhaps with my bible and a statue or picture or cross conducive to prayer? Such a focus might help me to remember this important aspect of my life. Some people find it helpful to keep a journal in which to record their feelings and thoughts during this time. Here are some questions for starters.

What experiences in the past few months have tested my faith? Have I taken that struggle to God in prayer? What experiences have strengthened my faith? Have I taken a moment to thank God for that growth? Though as Catholics, we don't have the tradition of going door to door evangelizing as some of our Protestant friends do, is there someone among my family and friends with whom I can share my faith and/or my challenges in believing? May the Spirit continue to keep our mustard seeds of faith growing!

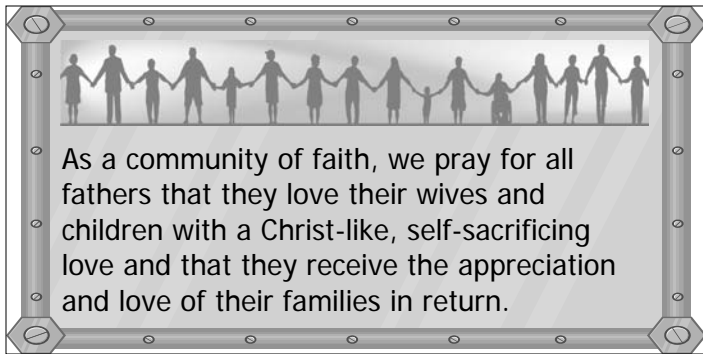

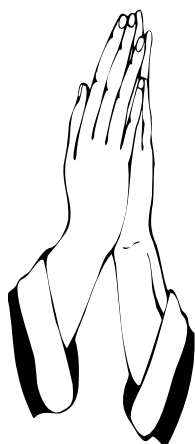
