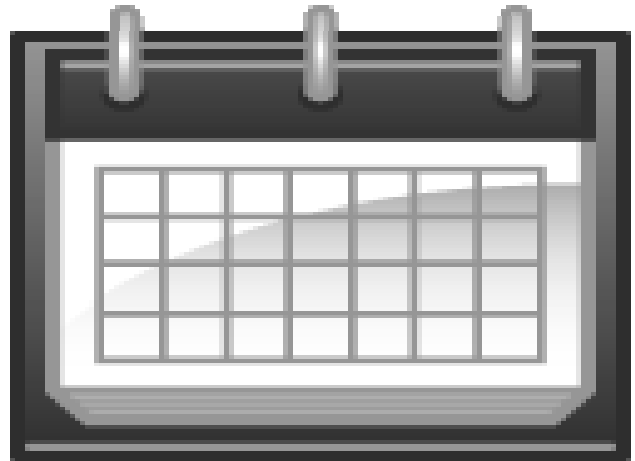
### **St. Anthony Stitchers**
