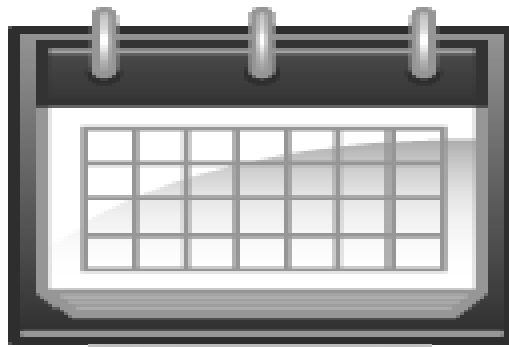
Consolation/Grief Ministry

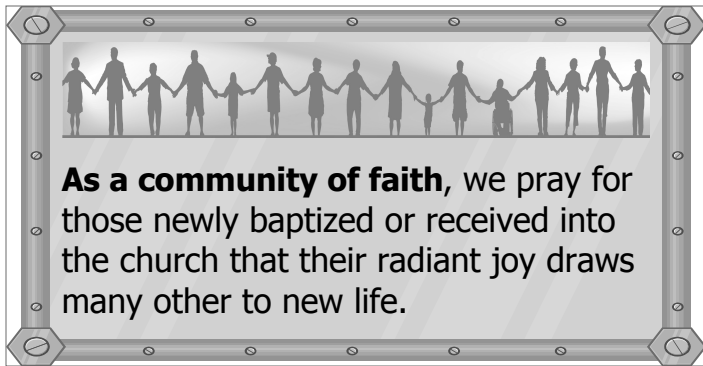
