Dear Friends,

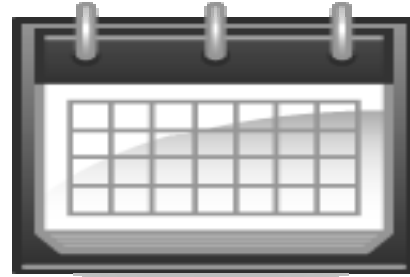
I sit here gazing at Gene's cheerful garden, sipping peppermint tea, as I recover from surgery. Today's Gospel, the story of the Good Samaritan, is very close to home to me. I have wonderful Good Samaritans lovingly taking care of me – My daughter Shirley and my two sisters Joan and Shirley. I am so very blessed and thank God for the gift of these lovely women. They give of themselves completely to love and serve me.

My thoughts turn to those who don't have loving, compassionate caregivers. I think of our poor, hungry and homeless sisters and brothers who are looked down upon because they are poor, hungry and homeless – many through no fault of their own. Do we cross over to the other side of the street when one of them comes into view? Do we look the other way when they ask us for help? Do we adamantly say: "Not in my neighborhood"?

The scholar of the law testing Jesus came up with this truth as to how to live: ***"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."*** When he asked Jesus who his neighbor was, Jesus told him the story of the Good Samaritan. Our neighbor lives among us. If we love God, we do have to love our neighbor. There are many places where we can live our love. To name a few: The Catholic Worker Hospitality House here in San Bruno; our St. Vincent de Paul Society and St. Anthony's Foundation. We can volunteer and work one-on-one with our neighbor. If we cannot physically be present to them we can share our treasure with them. In this way, we live our faith and live our love of God and of our sisters and brothers. As Gene so many times said: **"LOVE LIFE – LIVE LOVE."** and so he did!

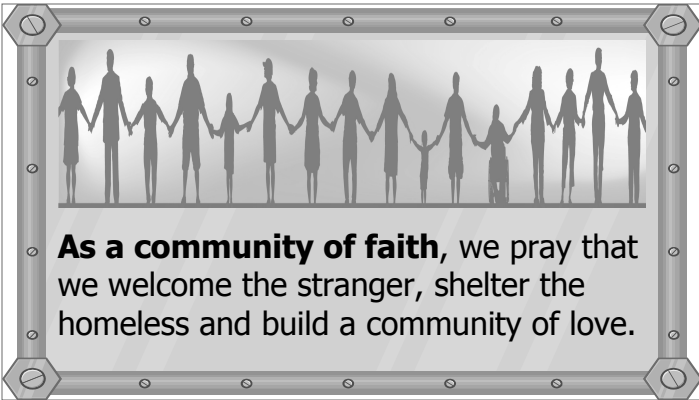

### ***For Our Low-Income Neighbors***

If you know people having trouble making ends meet with our astronomical rents, transportation costs, food, medical and child care, please tell them about Second Harvest Food Bank. As of last March, this agency has raised the income level for eligibility to 275% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). According to Housing and Urban Development studies, a household of four living in Santa Clara County is designated as low income if they earn less than \$94,450; in San Mateo County, that income is \$117,400. In these two counties, there are more than 700,000 people that have a household income less than 275% of FPL.

Second Harvest Food Bank has various programs to assist families and individuals in need of assistance in procuring healthy food for themselves and their households. Please help spread the word by giving them this phone number: 1-800-984-3663. They are open from 8 am til 5 pm Monday through Friday and have operators who speak English, Spanish, Chinese, Tagalog, Russian and Vietnamese.
