Dear Friends,

Golden leaves from Gene's crab apple tree surround me as I sip Vanilla Chai tea, here on our deck. Autumn is here! We find ourselves at the end of October, the month in which we celebrate the Sanctity of Life at all its stages from conception until natural death.

His command is: "**Love one another as I have loved you.**" His words mean that we are to respect every one of them; defend and protect them; reach out to them and help them – for it is in these precious children of God that Jesus lives!

Getting Ready for All Souls

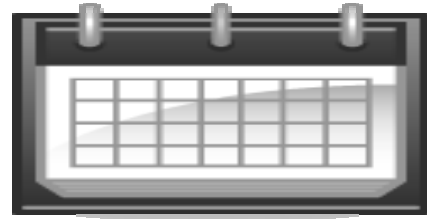
We at St. Robert's have a tradition of creating a Wall of Remembrance each November to prayerfully remember our loved ones who passed away between October 2018 - October 2019.

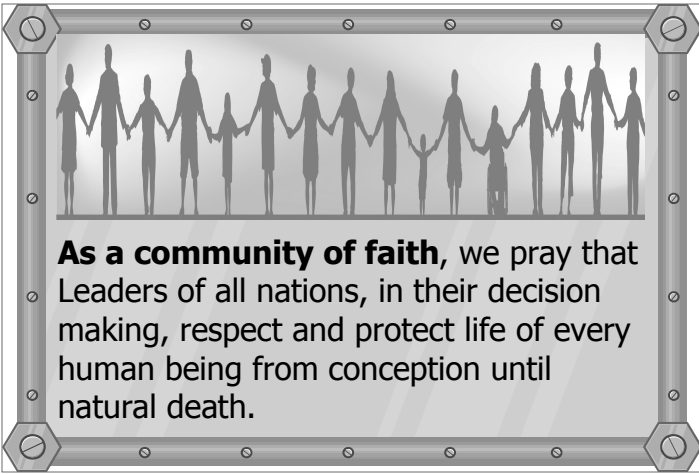
All Soul's Envelopes

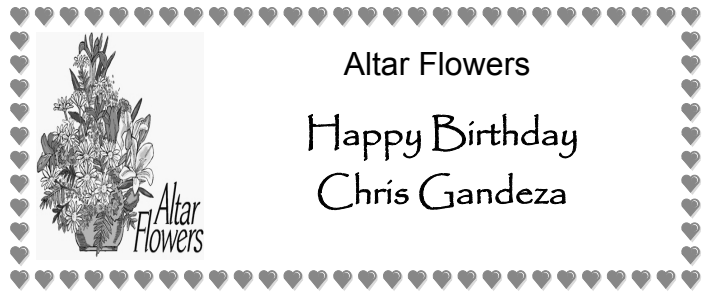
