What Is In A Title?

During Jesus's lifetime, the Apostles used many names to address Jesus: Rabbi, Master, Teacher, Son of Man, but only after the resurrection of Jesus did they use the words Son of God to describe him. Thomas the Apostle says to Jesus, " You are my Lord and my God. "

In today's Feast of the Transfiguration, Jesus tells them, they will not understand who he truly is until after he has been raised from the dead.

For this reason we know, that today's Gospel represents the faith and understanding of the Apostles after Jesus' death and resurrection.

As the Disciples of Jesus we recognize him both as Son of Man (a human being) and as the beloved Son of God. True God and True Man as we profess in our Sunday creed.

The Transfiguration tells us of the deepening faith of the apostles in Jesus. So too, may our own faith increase in Jesus as Lord and Savior.

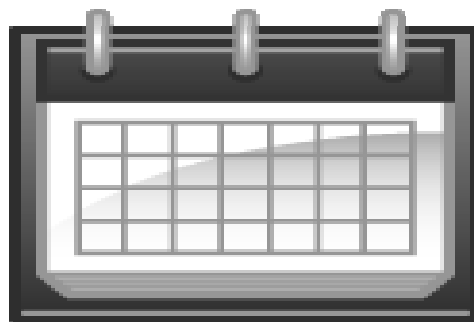
WEDNESDAY LENTEN MASS

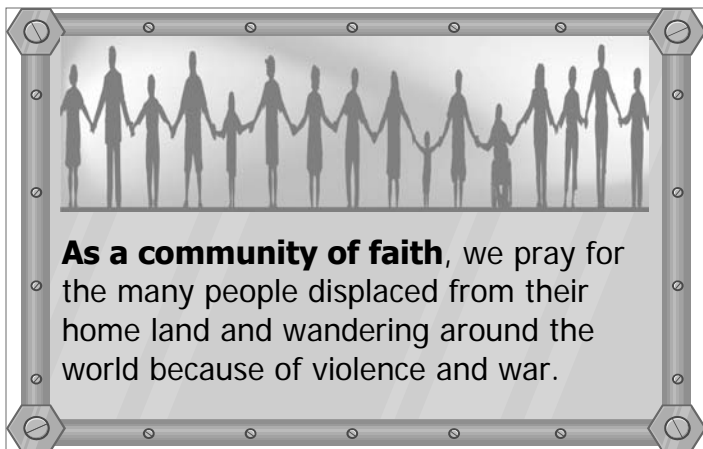

The regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent are the following:
On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics between the ages of **18 and 59 are obliged to fast**. Fasting means having one full meal and two smaller meals which do not equal the full one. It also means not eating between meals, though liquids are permitted. Abstinence refers to not eating meat (beef, pork, poultry). Catholics over the age of 14 are obliged to abstain on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. These regulations **do not apply** to those who for reasons of health or strenuous work cannot observe them.
