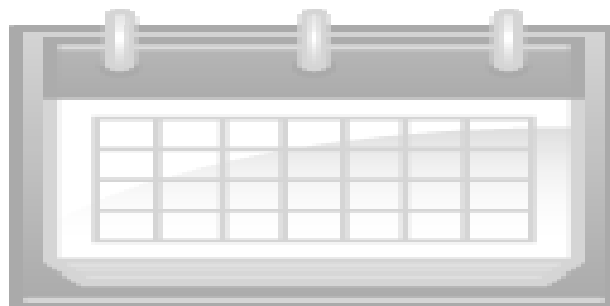
Mental Health Ministry
