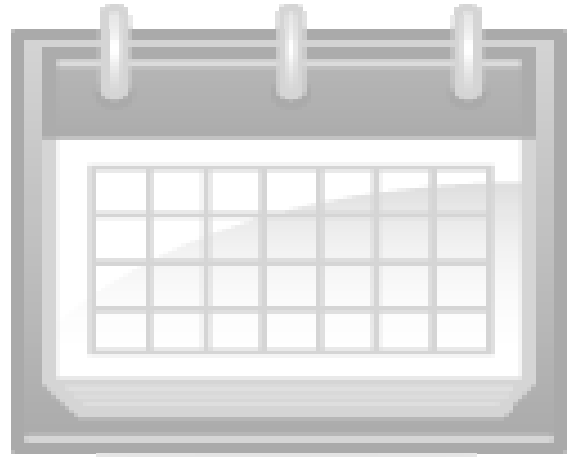
Take note we also have 7:30AM and 5:00PM masses this Sunday. All masses are indoor and livestreamed as well.

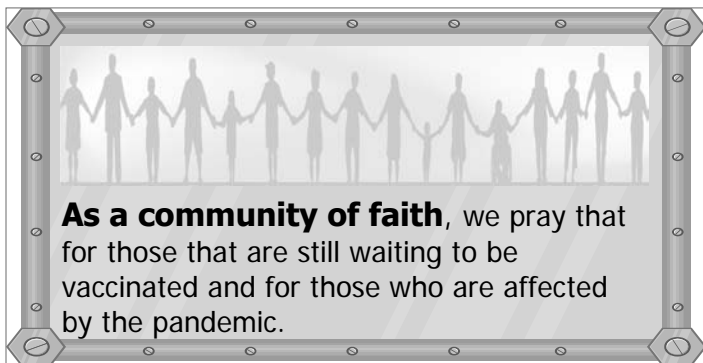
