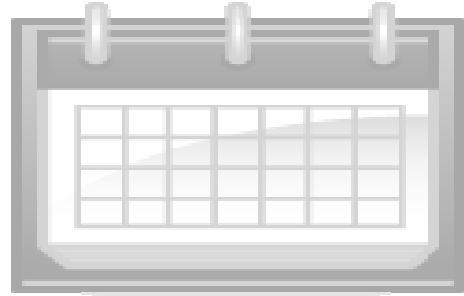
CONGRATULATIONS

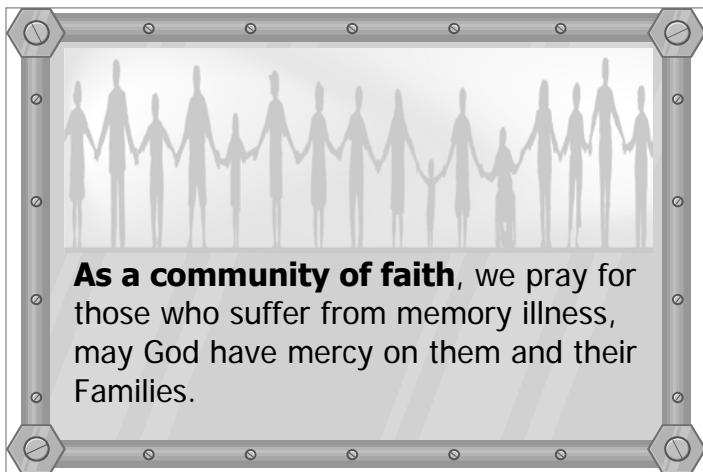
