We ask this through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

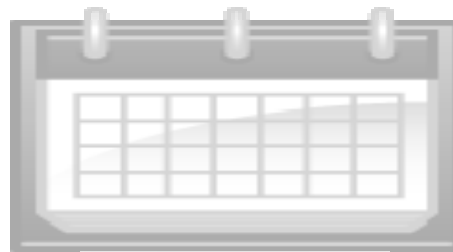
Dear parishioners and friends of St. Robert's,

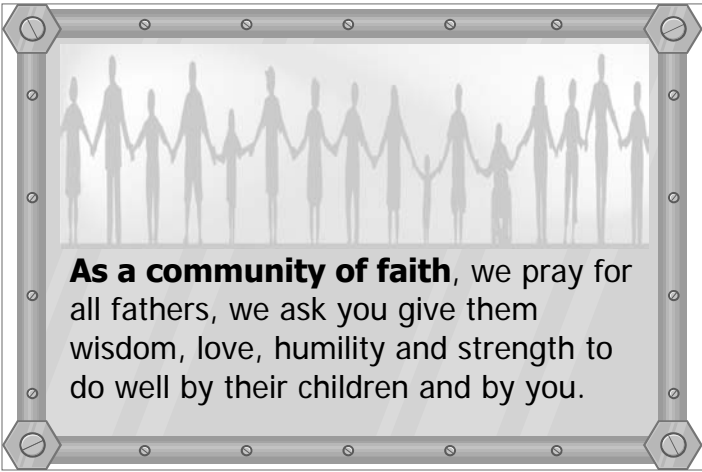
