**February 23rd - March 6th.**

The Holy Father has convened a Synod and has asked the People of God to participate in the synodal process. These sessions are available in-person at multiple locations across the Archdiocese, and also virtually using Zoom beginning on February 3rd until March 6th. Your participation is important and sincerely appreciated. A report of these sessions will be delivered to the US Conference of Catholic Bishops who will in turn submit a summary to the Holy Father in Rome.

### **MASK MANDATE**

In compliance with the state of California Covid mandate, the Archbishop issued a memo to all the priests in the Archdiocese to no longer require the use of masks inside the church – both the assembly and the liturgical ministers. However, masks are still recommended for precaution.

**PHISHERS of MEN!** A few parishioners informed me about getting an email from me asking for some gift cards and money. This is again email phishing, a fraudulent act pretending to be coming from me. **DO NOT RESPOND** to this email. Simply delete it and disregard it. But thank you for letting me know. I would say similar words that I received from a bank today: "If you receive a call or email asking you to provide any confidential information, do not engage. The bank will never ask to verify or divulge your personal information such as user account ID, password, account number, credit card number and CVV/ CVC via email link, text message or phone call"
