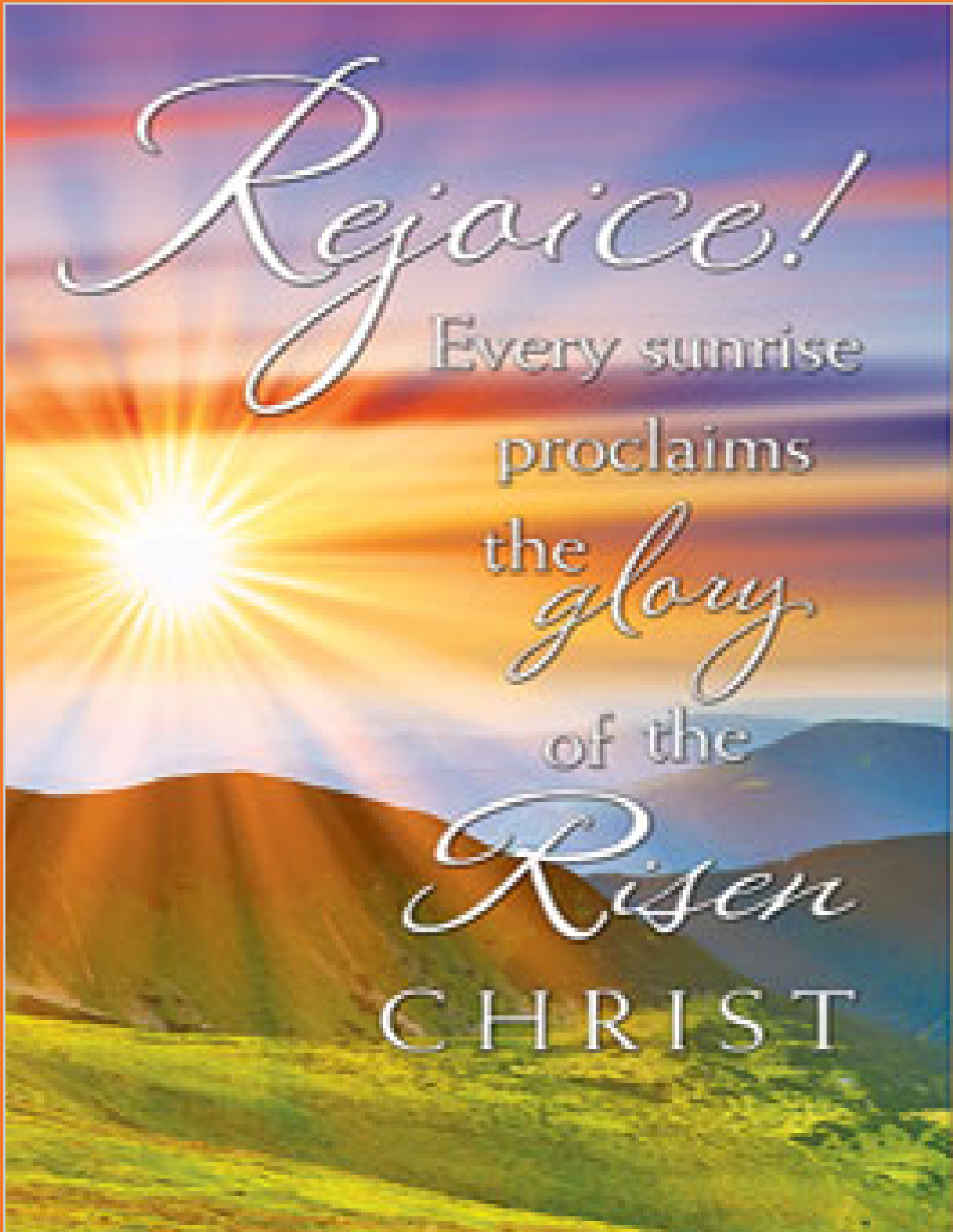


# Saint Robert's Church
