### Here are a few updates on some of our outstanding projects:

a. "SR Bear Walk Bricks" project: There remains a number of bricks to be installed on the other side of the planter box in front of the church which require good weather conditions (no cooler than 60°F) for best results. We are waiting for the perfect time and additional bricks to complete the whole square. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

b. The Grotto of our Lady of Lourdes: We are planning a groundbreaking ceremony on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, February 11, 2023, after the 4:30p.m. Mass, weather permitting. We thank our initial donors. So far, we have collected \$11,217.51 of the \$50,000 needed to complete the whole project. We will have an Easter Sunday concert by the world-renowned Philippine Madrigal Singers here in our church at 7:00p.m. Proceeds will help fund the grotto construction.

### NEXT GENERATION PARISH PROGRAM

Just before Christmas, I received wonderful news that St. Robert's has been awarded a scholarship to the Next Generation Parish program offered by the Archdiocese through the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI). What is the goal of a Next Generation Parish, and what would it look like? St. Robert's parish, after this experience, hopes to grow as a vibrant community of faith who journey together, Sunday after Sunday, closer to Jesus. It will provide the community, with the pastor's leadership, the opportunity to assess our greatest strengths as well as areas of growth. Based on this assessment, we will develop a four-year plan designed to transform our parish into a faith-filled community that is equipped to move into the future with a deeper missionary spirit. The program will start early next year.

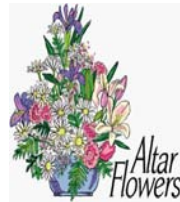
